Public Hearing: Informational meeting to discuss the self-contained breathing apparatuses and compressor for the Renville Fire Department

April 11, 2016

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the City Council of the City of Renville, Minnesota met for a public hearing at 6:45 p.m. Monday, April 11, 2016 in the Renville City Hall. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment on purchasing self-contained breathing apparatuses and compressor for the Renville Fire Department, including economic and environmental impacts, service area, alternatives to the project, and potential funding sources, including USDA Rural Development.

The hearing was called to order by Mayor Wertish. Council Members present were Shane Wohlman, Jeff Pike, Brent Dahl, Al Rohlik and Jeremy Hinderks. Also present were City Administrator/Clerk Kari Gislason and 15 members of the Renville Fire Department.

Notice of the Hearing was published in the Renville County Register March 24, 2016. No comments or questions were received at City Hall prior to the meeting.

Questions and discussion during the meeting included age of the current equipment. The newest tanks are from 2001. Presently, only 7 of 35 tanks are certifiable. Total expenses for equipment and breakdown for financing was reviewed. This included breakdowns of city and township percentages. A list of equipment was also reviewed.

A motion was made by Al Rohlik and seconded by Jeremy Hinderks to close the hearing. The motion carried 5 to 0. The hearing was adjourned at 6:55 pm.
