City Administrator Report

\* COVID-19/Legislative Update: The State House and Senate began the 2021 Session on Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup> at noon. All public hearings, committee meetings and House/Senate meetings are available by live webcast. On January 6<sup>th</sup>, the Governor announced limited reopening of some settings- including bars, restaurants, and certain venues. As of today, Renville County Public Health is reporting 1,351 confirmed cases (up 69 since previous Council meeting on 12/28) and 39 deaths (38 previous). Of those, 193 are specific to the 56284-zip code of Renville (up from 191). Today's Current Case Rate is 45.17 per 10,000.

\* Staff Reviews have been completed.

\* The Allied Solar (Pape Project) deadline extension has been filed with the County Recorder.

\* On December 29<sup>th</sup>, there was a contractor walk-through of the Community Center that I assisted with.

\* The final 2020 Law Summaries is complete. This includes laws relevant to cities from the regular legislative session and all seven special sessions.

\* With the anticipation that Police Officer Chad Segelstrom will be deployed for a year, Chief Slagter has been advertising for a replacement full-time officer.

\* I'm in the process of updating the MN DOT permit for the RRFB/Crosswalk project. The project requires a \$5,000 Security Deposit.

\* The City received the second half of our Local Government Aid (LGA) on 12/26 in the amount of \$238,637.50.

\* It's that time of year to start the renewal process for the City's Property/Casualty Insurance through the League of MN Cities Insurance Trust.

\* Included in your packet is a Coronavirus Fund Local Government Spending Report.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN AND PROVIDING

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.521 (the "Act"), cities are authorized to adopt a capital improvement plan and carry out programs for the financing of capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Renville, Minnesota (the "City"), has caused to be prepared a Capital Improvement Plan for the years 2021 through 2025 (the "Plan"); and

WHEREAS, on the date hereof, the City Council of the City (the "Council") has conducted a duly noticed public hearing regarding adoption of the Plan pursuant to the requirements of the Act and the issuance of general obligation bonds thereunder in a maximum principal amount of \$1,250,000; and

WHEREAS, in considering the Plan, the Board has considered:

1. the condition of the City's existing infrastructure, including the projected need for repair and replacement;
2. the likely demand for the improvement;
3. the estimated cost of the improvement;
4. the available public resources;
5. the level of overlapping debt in the City;
6. the relative benefits and costs of alternative uses of the funds;
7. operating costs of the proposed improvements; and

The Mayor would like to Thank Public Building Task Force for putting in a lot of time over the past 2 years turning over every stone to make these projects feasible.
