Business Spotlight: John Steinbach, President of Prairie Hemp Products spoke about his business expansion and growth. Their company owns multiple businesses from edibles, to gummies, and even printing. All of their products are tested and inspected through the State. Would like to consider utilizing the Industrial Park for additional production. Possibly 10-12 acres w/room for expansion and a workforce of 35-50 employees.

Jordan Zeller from Renville County EDA/HRA gave an update on loans processed for Dave's Place and Magnolia Market. Renville County Housing Committee update on tax abatement program. Southwest MN Housing Partnership proposal to work on housing needs within the community. The committee would like to follow-up and continue discussions with the County and Southwest MN Housing Partnership.

Renville Events Committee Request: REC is asking for \$500 for a Christmas tree and new lights for the lighting event. The committee recommends to the Council to approve \$500 for these items to come out of the EDA budget line.

Business Community Loan (BCL): The subcommittee presented the idea of upping the BCL loan to \$5,000 with a 24-month maturity (currently is \$3,000 at 18 months). A new program was also presented for new businesses called the Business Development Loan or BDL. This would be a \$6,000 loan for 36 months up to 3% interest with the last 12 months forgivable if certain criteria are met. The committee agreed that this would be a good opportunity. The final details and application will be created for approval.

Business Appreciation: The committee would like to put together a thank you token for the business community. This will be distributed by the committee members.

LED and Towable Sign Board: The LED sign is taking up space and there have not been any viable options to place it, so the feeling of the committee is to sell it. The towable sign was donated to the city when the Chamber disbanded and was administered by Pat at Country Rose (former Chamber member). When Pat retired the coordination fell back on the city. It was advised that if the city maintains the sign that a policy be put in place that addresses what is and isn't allowed, time frames, along with a request form. It was agreed by the committee to sell this sign as well due to the age and only being able to display one message at a time. The committee recommends that the Council declare both signs as surplus property and put them up for sale.

Nate Reuss spoke about the Mid-Minnesota Community Enhancement Fund grant opportunity.

Administrator update:

- Methodist Church is for sale.
- Community Impact Fund grant has been submitted for park trash receptacles.
- Jordan Zeller, Lisa Hughes with MN DEED, and Shane met with the new CEO of SMBSC, Paul Fry.
- Shane presented the CGMC 2023 Economic Development Policy.
- Manufacturing Week is October 17 – 21. The Mayor, Jordan, Nate, and Shane plan on delivering treats to the 4 manufacturers in Renville. An appreciation award was created and delivered from the City Council and EDA Committee as well.

#### City Administrator Report October 24, 2022

\* I had the pleasure of sitting on 4 out of the 5 policy committees for the Coalition of Greater MN Cities (CGMC). The committees that I was a part of included Economic Development; Property Taxes, LGA, and State Government Finance; Annexation and Land Use; and Environment and Energy. All the committees were very active and there was lots of good discussion. The proposed policies and changes are highlighted on the handouts. These will be formally adopted at the Fall Conference held on November 17-18 in Alexandria.

\* Preparations are well under way for the upcoming General Election on Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. Polls will be open at the Community Center from 7:00 am through 8:00 pm.

\* Tobacco and alcohol license renewals for 2023 have been put together and will be sent out shortly.

\* Public Works is gathering estimates for the damaged roofs from the storms. These will then be submitted to the LMCIT.

\* The MPCA Stormwater Resiliency Grant application was submitted on Monday, October 17<sup>th</sup>.

\* The Public Works Department replaced a curb stop at 309 S. Main today. There were about 12 customers that were without water while the repair was made. They have another replacement coming up at 216 NE Colfax that is being scheduled.

\* I'll be attending the annual MnWARN (Minnesota's Water/Wastewater Agency Response Network) meeting on Wednesday in St. Cloud.

\* Informational: 1. Renville County implementation of Local Option Sales Tax (LOST). A new tax of ½ percent (0.5%) will be effective January 1, 2023 to help fund roads and bridges. (handout) 2. There will be a budget meeting at the next Work session on November 14<sup>th</sup>.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS WITH THE CITY OF RENVILLE ON BEHALF OF ITS CITY  
ATTORNEY AND POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Renville on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department desires to enter into Joint Powers Agreements with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State’s criminal justice data communications network for which the City is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreements further provide the City with the ability to add, modify and delete connectivity, systems and tools over the five year life of the agreement and obligates the City to pay the costs for the network connection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Renville, Minnesota as follows:

1. That the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the City of Renville on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department, are hereby approved.
2. That the Police Chief, Aaron Slagter, or his or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Police Department. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City’s connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.
3. That the City Attorney, Jon Saunders, or his or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City’s connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.
4. That Janette Wertish, the Mayor for the City of Renville, and Shane Wohlman, the City Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
