1. Renville Business CARES Grants- Jordan Zeller from Renville County EDA and Rick Bonlender from Mid-Minnesota Development Commission were in attendance to assist the EDA with a plan to distribute the City of Renville's \$20,000 to aid local businesses. City Administrator Report

11-9-2020

- \* COVID-19/Legislative Update: As of 11:00 today, MN Department of Health shows Renville County is at 376 confirmed cases (up 126 from previous council meeting on 10/26) and 14 deaths (11 previous). 55 are specific to the City of Renville (up from 45- Renville County Dashboard).
- \* The Contamination Cleanup Grant was delivered to MN DEED office on October 30<sup>th</sup>.
- \* The General Election was held on November 3<sup>rd</sup> with 429 voters casting their ballots in person. This included 71 new registrants and 12 people that voted curbside.
- \* I have been asked to serve on two CGMC committees- Economic Development and Transportation. There are only a couple of meetings held virtually. These committees are responsible for setting policy positions for the Coalition cities for 2021.
- \* Assistant Public Works Director Matt Roxberg passed his Class C Water Operator Test.
- \* The School Board has invited the Community Improvement Alliance (CIA) group to a meeting on November 23<sup>rd</sup> to discuss the future/plans of the pool. An email has been sent out to this group notifying them of the meeting.
- \* Reminder that there is a Canvassing Hearing next Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> at 12:15 and a budget meeting following the next Council meeting on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- \* Census Recap- Again in Minnesota's case, the success at counting our neighbors is going to determine whether we keep our 8 Congressional seats and assure the proper allocation of over \$15 billion annually in federal funds that help support schools, agriculture, roads, businesses, among others. The self-response rate (which includes online, by mail, or by phone) for the Nation was 67%. MN response rate was 75.1% (#1 in Nation), Renville County self-response rate was 70.5% (47<sup>th</sup> out of 87 in MN) and the City of Renville census tract self-response rate was 61.6% (tied at 666 out of 845 in MN).
