City Administrator Report

- \* The Auditor finished up on Friday, March 6<sup>th</sup>. She is planning on attending the April 27<sup>th</sup> Council meeting to give her report.
- \* The new payloader for Public Works arrived last Wednesday and the lease papers have been signed.
- \* There was a water main break at the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street SW and Chestnut that occurred on Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>. There were 14 residences that were affected between Birch and Dogwood, and all received a phone call from City Hall notifying them that the repair was going to take place the following morning and water would be interrupted. The water was shut off for approximately 30 minutes while the repair was made.
- \* I attended the Housing Study meeting at the Government Center on February 27<sup>th</sup>. Matt Mullins from Maxfield Research & Consulting gave a presentation on what data and contacts that will need to be gathered by the participants for the study. Matt would like this information by March 13<sup>th</sup>.
- \* We just received the Phase II Environmental report (270 pages) and RAP (Response Action Plan) (28 pages) for the Main Street property. I am in the process of reviewing these reports and will be using this information to start the Contamination Cleanup Grant Application. We also just received our first payment from the Redevelopment Grant in the amount of \$18,245.
- \* The Presidential Primary was held on Tuesday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>. The polls were open from 7 am – 8 pm. There were 75 voters that turned out of the 625 registered (12%), with 4 new registrants.
- \* The Renville Fire Department was awarded a L.A. Amundson grant through First Security Bank in the amount of \$49,310. This will be used to outfit the rest of the department with 16 new fire suits, 25 helmets and 25 pairs of leather boots.
- \* I will be out of town from Monday 16<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm through Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup> but will still be available by phone or email.
